
Welcome to the latest issue of The Tornado Telegraph.

We have plenty to report from the past six weeks work on *Tornado*. The boiler arrived in Darlington prompting a hive of activity at DLW as we gear up for the steam test in two weeks' time. In Loughborough, the team there are busy getting the frames prepared ready for the boiler to be returned, as the whole locomotive comes back together. DLW2 (the new home for the Trust) continues to take shape and we plan to move across this summer. Additionally, we are delighted to be visiting the North Norfolk Railway at the end of May - more details on that below!

Earlier this week, you will have received the news of the extended timeframe for the A1's overhaul, inevitably meaning the start of *Tornado*'s railtour programme is pushed back to the summer, rather than beginning in March as originally planned. BOILER WORK IN DARLINGTON

In mid-December we received the early Christmas present that we had waited so long for: the A1's overhauled boiler returned to Darlington, transported from Meiningen by Allelys. Since then, the team has wasted no time and *Tornado's* boiler has been subject

to much activity with the replacement of many of the overhauled fittings and a start made on recladding the cleaned and painted boiler barrel. Shortly after its arrival, the boiler passed its hydraulic exam, although some light remedial work has been recommended. The tender is now all but complete and painted, with the ETCS locker ready for the heart of the digital signalling equipment to be fitted. The frames have been painted and pipework installed ahead of final alignment checks in preparation for the wheels to be returned. TORNADO ON TOUR TO NORFOLK



No. 60163 *Tornado* will be paying a visit to the North Norfolk Railway from 27^{th} May to 4^{th} June, hauling special trains from Sheringham to Holt and return.

This will be one of the locomotive's first appearances following the overhaul, so tickets are expected to sell fast. No. 60163 spends most of its time hauling premier excursions on the mainline, so grab your tickets for this rare chance to ride behind one of Britain's most famous locomotives on a heritage railway.

Special trains hauled by *Tornado* will depart from Sheringham Station at 10.00, 11.40, 13.20, 15.00 and 16.40 each day from 27th May to 4th June. Tickets will include a reserved seat for a trip from Sheringham to Holt and return with time at Holt Station to take photographs of the express engine. *Tornado* will also haul 'The North Norfolkman' dining train on Saturday 3 June - advance booking is essential.

Fares for advance bookings vary from £19 to £21 for adults and £13.00 and £14.50 for children.



DLW2 - A NEW HOME FOR THE TRUST



After all the excitement of the new works building rising from the ground at an impressive rate, the hub of activity has moved from the structure to the interior where the first rails have been laid into the ground. The above photo shows the scale of the works, which will be able to house four locomotives of A1/P2 length. Out the front of the shed, the all-important inspection pit has been installed.


A "permanent way gang" is a long-standing term for track workers and engineers, and honouring that tradition, we ask you to make a contribution to join our P-Way Gang.


