Welcome to the latest issue of The Tornado Telegraph.

It seems like every other update we send you brings another wave of obstacles and difficulties delaying *Tornado*'s return to steam. Following the jubilation on the repatriation of the A1's refurbished boiler, it was hoped that a hydraulic and steam test would go smoothly and it would be reunited with the frames soon after. Alas, this has not been the case.

On arrival in the U.K., and following inspection by British Engineering Services, there has been a concern around the quality and installation of the small tubes in *Tornado*'s boiler. At present we are not able to confirm if this is a material or welding issue so all parties (A1SLT, DB Meiningen and BES) have agreed that the most expeditious action is to replace the small tubes whilst we investigate the issue. This approach will not only ensure continued quality and reliability but will be the fastest route to complete the boiler ready for installation on the frames.

Whilst we are obviously disappointed that there is additional work required in this area, we are working hard to return *Tornado* to the rails as soon as possible. Our focus now is on completing the locomotive ahead of its planned visit to the North Norfolk Railway, ETCS testing at RIDC (near Melton Mowbray) and we remain committed to running the

first of the Aberdonian trains on 20th July 2023.

The re-tubing itself will be covered by the boiler's warranty, however *Tornado* has been away from the main line longer than anticipated, which is having an impact on our earning capability. If you are able to help us at this time by making a donation, it will go directly towards the wider overhaul, returning *Tornado* to the rails in top condition.

#### **TORNADO ON TOUR**

We are working with our industry partners to confirm all trains for *Tornado* in 2023. We will be running some of our own tours promoted by <u>21st Century Steam Ltd</u>, and it is likely that we will also participate in a number of third party tours. Our own tours will give new dates to postponed trains, and also introduce a couple of new routes, seeing *Tornado* visit even more of the country. We expect to have these dates confirmed and on sale in the coming weeks.

Our 'Aberdonian' trains are selling well, with 'Premier Dining' already sold out on the first train; always a popular way to travel, Dining tickets are likely to sell out across the programme, so book early to avoid disappointment. First Class on passengers on 'The Aberdonian' take their seats in a compartment, making for a superb alternative to Premier Dining. The offer in Tourist Class is also improved this year, and we look forward to welcoming many familiar faces back on board.

## **VISITING THE NORTH NORFOLK**



Following the overhaul, the first planned public access to *Tornado* will be during her time at the North Norfolk railway 27<sup>th</sup> May to 4<sup>th</sup> June.

Special trains hauled by *Tornado* will depart from Sheringham Station at 10.00, 11.40, 13.20, 15.00 and 16.40 each day. Tickets will include a reserved seat for a trip from Sheringham to Holt and return with time at Holt Station to take photographs of the express engine. *Tornado* will also haul 'The North Norfolkman' dining train on Saturday 3 June - advance booking is essential.

Fares for advance bookings vary from £19 to £21 for adults and £13.00 and £14.50 for children.
