## Making a bequest to The AI Steam Locomotive Trust

- How has legacy funding been used by the Trust?**  
 Legacies helped the Trust during the construction of No. 60163 *Tornado* by funding specific components and equipment in Darlington Locomotive Works. Legacies will become an increasingly important part of No. 2007 *Prince of Wales*' life, some legacies left towards No. 2007 have already been put to good use.
- What will my legacy go towards?**  
 A bequest left in your Will, will be hypothecated as per the donors wishes. We have various accounts set up for different projects and legacies are always used in the area they are intended for. If you do not state a specific use, we will devote your gift to whichever area of the project needs your assistance at the time. If, however you would like your legacy to be used for something more specific, you will need to talk to our Legacy Coordinator in order to realise your contribution and by doing this we will be certain that your gift will be used for a specific purpose.
- To whom do I make my bequest?**  
 The AI Steam Locomotive Trust (1022834) is the organisation that holds the funds for fundraising projects and has Trustees that can accept bequests for any purpose linked to it. Please detail in your Will the project you wish your legacy to be given to, be this No. 2007 *Prince of Wales*, No. 60163 *Tornado* or any other on-going project of the Trust. The Trust is governed by a Council and its Trustees will ensure your wish is fulfilled.

If the value of your estate is above a nil rate band threshold value then it will be liable for inheritance tax (IHT). Any gifts made to UK registered charities are exempt from IHT and further tax savings can be made if you gift more than 10% of your net estate to charity as the IHT tax rate reduces to 36%. A gift to The AI Steam Locomotive Trust would be classed as a charitable gift and therefore attract the favourable tax rules. If your estate is chargeable to IHT, specialist advice should be sought.
- How do I make a Will?**  
 You could simply fill out a form from a major stationer or online but if your affairs are a little more complex it would be much better to take advice from a solicitor: It costs between £150 and £200 to make a Will. Our Charity Registration Number is 1022834; please specify in your will which project you wish your legacy to go to.
- Can I update my existing Will?**  
 Yes, you will need to produce a document called a codicil; it is not that complicated and suitable forms are available from [www.p2steam.com](http://www.p2steam.com) or from our Legacy Coordinator.
- What wording do I use?**  
 It depends on how you wish to divide up your estate. Details are available on [www.p2steam.com](http://www.p2steam.com) or from our Legacy Coordinator.




## Supporting No. 2007

The Gresley class P2 2-8-2 'Mikados' were the most powerful express passenger locomotives to operate in the UK. They were designed by Sir Nigel Gresley to haul 600 ton trains on the arduous Edinburgh to Aberdeen route. Sadly the design was never fully developed and they were rebuilt by his successor Edward Thompson into ungainly class A2/2 4-6-2 'Pacifics' in 1943/4, and scrapped by 1961. As the builders of No. 60163 *Tornado*, we have set ourselves a new challenge: to develop, build and operate an improved Gresley class P2 'Mikado' steam locomotive for main line and preserved railway use.

The project to build the 7<sup>th</sup> Gresley class P2 'Mikado' is using the latest computer design and modelling techniques to enable it to deliver its true potential.

### The new locomotive will:

- Be aesthetically similar to class P2 No. 2001 *Cock o' the North* - it is a construction and development project not an opportunity for major redesign
- Make maximum use of systems, fittings and processes in use on No. 60163 *Tornado* - any changes to the original design will be either for operational, manufacturing or certification reasons
- Take into account the needs of the operator - all decisions will be judged for their value for money
- Meet current and foreseeable regulatory standards to allow the locomotive to operate as intended.

We estimate that No. 2007 *Prince of Wales* will cost around £5m to build over a 7-10 year period.

Funds to build *Prince of Wales* are being raised through our regular donation - Covenant scheme - "a P2 for the price of a pint of beer a week", Clubs dedicated to large expensive components, such as The Boiler Club, The Mikado Club, The Cylinder Club and The Motion Club, component sponsorship and commercial sponsorship (William Cook Cast Products - principal sponsor). Today, The A1 Steam Locomotive Trust continues to operate *Tornado* on the Network Rail main line and is building a brand new 'Mikado' class P2 locomotive.

You can help ensure that No. 2007 *Prince of Wales* has a secure future on the main line for generations to come by leaving a legacy to The A1 Steam Locomotive Trust in your Will.

Donations towards the construction and upkeep of No. 60163 *Tornado* from legacies and more recently No. 2007 *Prince of Wales* have been relatively infrequent - although the Trust has always been extremely grateful for any gifts received. It would be very beneficial if the Trust could come in line with the top UK based charities where legacy donations make up around 40% of fundraising income.
