Finally, after many months of waiting patiently at the National Railway Museum, York, No. 60163 *Tornado* was back in service on the main line. On Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> May, The A1 Steam Locomotive Trust ran 'The Pennine Explorer', after an early morning departure from Leicester, an hour and a half later *Tornado* was coupled to the train at Barrow Hill North Junction. Departing ahead of time meant some steady running north to join the East Coast Main Line (ECML) at Colton Junction and after a stop at York we were back on schedule. Despite some checks on the run north *Tornado* stretched her legs out a little up to the water stop at Tursdale Junction and then past Tyne Yard before taking the Tyne Valley Line west to Carlisle.

Arriving at Carlisle, several signalling failures made what should have been an easy turning and servicing move somewhat more complex. However, despite the challenges, the locomotive was serviced, turned, and back on the train for a slightly delayed departure to begin the run over the Settle and Carlisle Line (S&C). Those who witnessed the climb over Ais Gill have described it using many superlatives, and it was certainly a remarkable performance, with the train breaching the summit before the tunnel at 55 mph. The run down through Blea Moor and over Ribblehead offered the usual spectacular scenery and there were plenty of folks about capturing the moment as we passed.

At Hellifield, *Tornado* gave up her position at the head of the train and after a brief top up of water, headed back to stable at the National Railway Museum in York. The support crew examined both the locomotive and support coach carefully the following morning and all seems in good order ahead of our next outing up the ECML to Edinburgh later this month.






